






2012: Niche identification

Integrated research as the operational niche for Africa RISING.



- Biophysical research to aim more at validating ecological intensification technologies - within interception zones 4, 5, 6 and 7 across landscapes/agroecosystems.
- Concurrent socio-economic studies to identify which of the efficient technologies identified would be most effective.



What guided our planning for 2018-2019?

Consolidation:

- Integrated (systems) research
- Toward completing validation of technologies for their potential using the SIAF
- Validation to be scientific (quality research)
- Increasing our contribution to custom indicators, including the Handbook!
- Engaging development partners for technology delivery and scaling
- Improved contribution to M&E requirements
